General storytelling ideas/prompts:

- When did you first learn about MOCSA?
- Why is MOCSA's mission important to you?
- What do you want people to know about supporting survivors?
- What does "My moment. Our momentum." mean to you? (SAAM theme)
- What are you doing for SAAM this year and why is it important?
- What is an issue related to sexual violence that needs to change?

Prompts for volunteers/staff:

- What inspired you get involved with MOCSA?
- Share a memorable moment from your experiences working with survivors, colleagues, students, community members, etc.
- Share a time when you felt you made an impact.

Prompts for students:

- How did you first hear about MOCSA?
- What is something you've learned about sexual violence? And why is it important?
 - consent
 - bystander intervention
 - boundaries
 - healthy relationships
 - gender stereotypes
- What do you want your peers/friends to know about ...
- Share a time when you were faced with a decision about ...

Prompts for community partners:

- What changes have you seen in our community's response to survivors?
- What changes are still needed?
- How does culture change around sexual violence impact your work?
